# Prepare for Your Abdominal liposuction Trip to Turkey



### **Documents and Visa Requirements**

- · Valid passport or travel ID that is recognized by Turkish authorities.
- Visa, if required. Check the Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System at <a href="https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/">https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/</a> or the nearest Turkish consulate for your specific country's requirements.
- · Medical documents such as health history, any previous surgery records, and details of current medications.
- Clinics in Turkey can provide diagnostics and tests if the patient lacks certain medical documents; however, bringing existing documents is
  advised.



### **Accommodation Options**

Many clinics have partnerships with local hotels, offering discounted rates. Some may offer free accommodation for a specific duration related to your procedure package. Hospital stays are typically included in the procedure cost. For self-booking, the average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150, depending on the hotel's quality and location.



### **Transfer Services**

- · Free airport transfers are often included in medical packages. Check with your clinic for confirmation.
- Popular taxi services include BiTaksi and iTaksi, with approximate costs of \$0.50-\$1.00 per km.



## **Interpreter Services**

Interpreter services are generally available and may be included in the medical package. If not, they can be arranged for a fee, which varies based on the language and duration required.



### **Payment Methods**

- · Cash and card payments are widely accepted. Ensure your card is enabled for international transactions.
- The local currency is Turkish Lira (TRY). It's advisable to have some local cash for small expenses, although USD and EUR are also accepted in many places.



## **Pre-Op Abdominal liposuction Tips**

- Stop smoking and avoid alcohol consumption at least two weeks before the surgery to enhance healing.
- Maintain a healthy diet and stay hydrated leading up to the procedure.
- Discuss your current medications with your surgeon as some may need to be paused.
- Arrange for someone to assist you post-surgery if possible, as your mobility may be limited.
- Prepare loose-fitting clothing for your comfort post-surgery.
- Follow all pre-operative instructions given by your surgeon for the best outcomes.
- Get plenty of rest before your trip to ensure you're in good health for the surgery.
