Documents and Visa Requirements

- Ensure you have a valid passport for international travel to Turkey.
- Check visa requirements on the official Republic of Turkey Ministry of Foreign Affairs website or via their e-Visa portal (www.evisa.gov.tr).
- · Bring medical documents such as dental records, X-rays, and any dental treatment plans you may have.
- · Clinics in Turkey typically provide necessary diagnostics and tests for patients missing certain medical documents.



Accommodation Options

Many clinics partner with 4* hotels, offering discounted rates or included accommodation as part of the treatment package. You may also self-book your accommodations if preferred. Hospital stays are typically included in the treatment duration. Average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150, depending on the hotel's quality and location.



Transfer Services

- Many clinics offer free airport transfers, while some may charge an additional fee.
- Popular taxi services such as BiTaksi and iTaksi are available in major cities, with approximate prices starting from \$0.5 to \$1 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided free of charge by the clinics. However, if not included, patients can arrange for paid interpreter services through various agencies.



Payment Methods

- · Clinics accept payments in cash and by card.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira, but many places also accept dollars or euros.
- Having local cash can be convenient for smaller expenses and in areas that may not accept cards.



Pre-Op All-on-6 Dental Implants Tips

- Consult with your local dentist before traveling and bring a copy of your dental records.
- Maintain good oral hygiene to reduce the risk of infection post-procedure.
- Avoid smoking and alcohol consumption as they can hinder the healing process.
- Eat a healthy diet and stay hydrated before your procedure to ensure optimal health.
- Plan for adequate recovery time in Turkey, following the clinic's recommended stay.
- Bring comfortable clothing and essentials for the duration of your stay in the hospital and hotel.
- Make sure you understand the postoperative care instructions provided by your dental surgeon.
- Have a local SIM card or roaming plan to stay connected with your medical coordinator and clinic.
