# **Prepare for Your Breast cancer Treatment in Spain**



#### **Documents and Visa Requirements**

- · Passport valid for at least six months beyond your stay.
- · European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) if applicable.
- · Travel insurance with adequate health coverage.
- · Check visa requirements based on your country of origin at the official website of the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- · Necessary medical documents include a referral from your doctor, medical history, and any previous mammograms or biopsies.
- Spanish clinics offer diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are unavailable.



#### **Accommodation Options**

Accommodation is not included in the treatment package. Patients can choose from hospital stays, partner hotels with discounts, or self-booking options. The average hotel stay per night is around €100-€200. Arrangements can be made for accompanying persons with conditions varying depending on the hotel's policy.



## **Transfer Services**

- Clinics may offer free or paid airport transfers. Confirm with the clinic beforehand.
- Popular taxi services include Taxi Barcelona and Taxi Madrid with approximate prices ranging from €30 to €100 depending on the distance.



# **Interpreter Services**

Interpreter services are available and may be included in the treatment package or provided at an additional cost. Confirm with the clinic.



#### **Payment Methods**

- Payments can be made using cash or card.
- The local currency is the Euro (€), and it is advisable to have some on hand for minor expenses.
- · Major establishments often accept payment in euros or dollars, but local cash is recommended for comfort.



#### **Before Your Breast cancer Treatment**

- Follow any pre-treatment instructions provided by your doctor, such as fasting or medication adjustments.
- Bring comfortable clothing and personal items for your hospital stay.
- Make copies of all important documents and keep them in a safe place.
- Stay hydrated and maintain a healthy diet before the treatment.
- Discuss any concerns or questions with your medical coordinator.
- Ensure you have a support system in place for your post-treatment recovery period.
- Prepare your home for your return to facilitate a comfortable and safe recovery environment.
- Remember that all postoperative instructions will be given by your Breast cancer treatment doctor.
