Your Guide to Prepare for Cervical cancer Treatment in Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- · Passport valid for at least six months beyond your stay.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the e-Visa website (https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/) for specific information.
- Medical records detailing your health condition, previous treatments, and Cervical cancer diagnosis.
- If certain medical documents are missing, Turkish clinics can provide diagnostics and tests such as blood tests, PET/CT, and histopathology revision.



Accommodation Options

Accommodation is not typically included with medical procedures. However, some packages offer a 4* hotel stay. Partner hotels may offer discounts, and assistance is available for booking at special prices. Average hotel stay per night may range from approximately \$50 to \$150. Accommodations for an accompanying person are available but conditions vary, so it's advisable to confirm with the clinic or hotel.



Transfer Services

- · Some medical packages include airport-hotel-clinic transfers.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi operate in major cities, with fares starting around 2-3 TRY per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services may be available upon request, often for a fee. Be sure to arrange this service in advance if you do not speak Turkish.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made using cash or card.
- The local currency is Turkish Lira (TRY), and it's recommended to have some for minor expenses.
- Major establishments may accept dollars or euros, but local currency is preferred.



Before Your Cervical cancer Treatment

- Consult with your local doctor about the planned treatment and any preparatory steps you may need to take.
- Ensure all your current medical information is up to date and ready to be shared with your treatment team in Turkey.
- Consider banking your blood in case a transfusion is needed.
- Plan for at least 2-3 days of accommodation post-treatment for initial recovery and follow-up appointments.
- Prepare a list of medications and allergies to discuss with the medical team.
- Abstain from smoking and alcohol as they may affect your recovery.
- Organize personal affairs and necessary support for your return home post-treatment.
- All postoperative instructions will be given by your Cervical cancer treatment doctor.
