Documents and Visa Requirements

- International travelers to Turkey should have a valid passport with at least 6 months remaining from the date of entry.
- Check visa requirements based on your country of origin at the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System website or consult the nearest Turkish consulate.
- · Medical documents needed: referral from your doctor, medical history, and any previous treatment records pertaining to your condition.
- Clinics in Turkey may provide diagnostics and tests if you lack certain medical documents, upon arrival, before proceeding with CyberKnife treatment.



Accommodation Options

Most clinics do not include accommodation in the treatment package. Patients can stay in hospital facilities, partner hotels with discounts, or self-book accommodations. Clinics often have agreements with local hotels for reduced rates. The average hotel stay per night can vary widely, but expect to pay approximately \$50 to \$150.



Transfer Services

- Some clinics offer free airport transfers, while others may charge an additional fee.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi operate in major cities, with approximate prices starting from \$0.40 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided free of charge by the clinics during your medical stay. However, confirm this with your clinic before your



Payment Methods

- Payments can usually be made with cash or credit/debit card.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY), and it's recommended to have some on hand for small purchases and convenience.
- . Many places in Turkey also accept payments in dollars or euros, but the best exchange rates are typically found with local currency.



Pre-Op CyberKnife Tips

- Discuss all medications and supplements you are taking with your doctor, as some may need to be paused before treatment.
- Follow any dietary restrictions or fasting instructions provided by your medical team prior to the procedure.
- Plan for adequate rest and recovery time post-treatment and arrange for assistance if necessary.
- Bring comfortable, loose-fitting clothing for your stay and treatment sessions.
- Stay hydrated and maintain a healthy diet to support your body's healing process.
- Prepare a list of questions or concerns to discuss with your medical team before the procedure.
- Ensure you have all necessary travel insurance and health coverage documents in order.
- Remember that postoperative instructions will be provided by your CyberKnife doctor, so adhere to them closely for the best recovery outcome.
