Prepare for Your Deep brain stimulation (DBS) surgery Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- · Valid passport and a copy of your passport's data page.
- Visa, if required. Check the current visa requirements for Turkey at the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System (https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/) or consult the nearest Turkish embassy.
- · Medical referral letter, imaging and test results, and a list of current medications.
- · Clinics in Turkey may provide additional diagnostics and tests if necessary medical documents are lacking.



Accommodation Options

In Turkey, accommodation options include hospital stays during treatment, partner hotels at discounts, or self-booking. Clinics often provide free accommodation before and after surgery, including up to 3 weeks for recovery and neurostimulator programming. Expect a hotel stay to average around \$50-\$100 per night if not included in the package.



Transfer Services

- · Clinics usually offer free airport transfers.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available, with prices starting from around ₹3.00 per km (\$0.16 USD).



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided for free during the DBS Program in Turkey, ensuring seamless communication throughout your medical journey.



Payment Methods

- Payment can be made in cash or by card. International credit cards are widely accepted.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY), but many places also accept USD or EUR.



Pre-Op Deep brain stimulation (DBS) surgery Tips

- Follow any pre-operative instructions provided by your medical team, including fasting or medication adjustments.
- Organize all your medical records and ensure you have them readily available.
- Discuss with your surgeon any concerns and clarify the postoperative care and support you will receive.
- Plan for a recovery period and arrange for someone to assist you post-surgery if needed.
- Bring comfortable and loose clothing for post-operative comfort.
- Ensure you have a method of communication; consider a local SIM card or roaming plan.
- Rest adequately before surgery to help with recovery.
- Stay hydrated and follow a healthy diet as advised by your healthcare provider.
