

Prepare for Your Dental Crown Installation Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- A valid passport is essential for international travel to Turkey.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the latest information on the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System at www.evisa.gov.tr.
- Ensure you have medical records related to your dental health and any previous dental treatments.
- Clinics in Turkey may provide diagnostics like panoramic X-rays or volumetric tomography if certain medical documents are missing.



Accommodation Options

Clinics often partner with local hotels, offering discounted rates to international patients. Some packages include free accommodation, while others may require payment. Hospital stays for the procedure are typically included. The average hotel stay per night varies, with 4* hotels averaging around \$50-\$100 and 5* hotels around \$100-\$200 per night.



Transfer Services

- Many clinics offer free airport transfers as part of their treatment packages.
- For independent travel, popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi can be used, with prices starting around ₺3.00-₺4.00 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided free of charge by the clinics. However, if a personal interpreter is required for the duration of the stay, additional costs may apply.



Payment Methods

- Payment options include cash and credit/debit cards.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY), but many establishments also accept dollars or euros.
- It is advisable to have some local currency for small expenses and in areas that do not accept cards or foreign currency.



Pre-Op Dental Crown Installation Tips

- Discuss any current medications with your dentist to ensure they won't interfere with the procedure.
- Avoid smoking and alcohol consumption before the procedure to promote better healing.
- Follow a soft diet a day before the procedure to minimize dental stress.
- Ensure you have a reliable companion for support during the initial recovery period.
- Stay hydrated and well-rested before the day of your dental crown installation.
- Plan your schedule to allow for ample recovery time post-procedure, especially if you have received sedation or general anesthesia.
- Bring a list of questions or concerns to address with your dentist during the consultation.
- Remember that specific postoperative instructions will be given by your dental crown installation doctor.
