

Prepare for Your Denture Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport with a minimum validity of 6 months beyond the stay.
- Visa requirements vary by country. Check the Republic of Turkey's e-Visa application system at www.eviza.gov.tr or visit the nearest Turkish embassy.
- Medical records, dental x-rays, and a list of current medications.
- Clinics in Turkey can provide necessary diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are missing.



Accommodation Options

Most clinics have partnerships with local hotels offering discounted rates. Some may offer free accommodation during the medical stay. Hospital stays are usually covered in the medical package. Average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150.



Transfer Services

- Clinics commonly offer free airport-clinic-hotel transfers.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available, with prices starting around 2-3 TRY per km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are usually provided for free by the clinics. However, it's always good to confirm this prior to your trip.



Payment Methods

- Cash and card payments are accepted.
- Local currency (Turkish Lira - TRY) is needed for smaller expenses; however, dollars or euros are widely accepted.



Pre-Op Denture Tips

- Refrain from smoking and alcohol consumption at least a week before surgery.
- Inform your dentist about any medications you are taking.
- Plan to arrive in Turkey a few days before the procedure to adjust and rest.
- Maintain good oral hygiene but avoid aggressive brushing near the surgical site.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you during the initial recovery period.
- Ensure you have a clear understanding of the procedure and post-op care before traveling.
- Keep a list of emergency contacts and the clinic's address with you.
