Prepare for Your Eyebrow Transplantation Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of entry into Turkey.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the latest information at <u>Turkey's Electronic Visa Application System</u>.
- · Medical documents: referral from your local doctor, any relevant medical history, and pre-op photographs.
- Clinics in Turkey may offer diagnostic tests such as Anti-HIV, Anti-HBC, Anti-HCVAb tests, and a pre-operative blood test if you lack certain medical documents.



Accommodation Options

Most clinics in Turkey offer a package that includes 3 nights of 5-star hotel accommodation. Clinics typically partner with nearby hotels to provide discounted rates or include the cost in the treatment package. If you prefer self-booking, the average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150, depending on the location and hotel rating.



Transfer Services

- Complimentary VIP airport transfers are often included in medical packages.
- Popular taxi services in Turkey include BiTaksi and iTaksi, with approximate prices starting from 3 TRY (\$0.16) per km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are typically provided free of charge throughout the procedure, with 24/7 post-operation assistance available in multiple languages.



Payment Methods

- Cash payments are preferred; credit card payments are accepted with a 10% tax.
- Local currency (Turkish Lira TRY) is required for smaller expenses; USD and EUR are widely accepted for larger transactions.



Pre-Op Eyebrow Transplantation Tips

- Have a light breakfast on the day of the operation.
- Do not shave your hair before the procedure; it will be done at the clinic if necessary.
- Avoid alcohol consumption at least one week prior to the operation.
- Wear a button-down shirt or a zip-up jacket on the day of the operation for ease of dressing post-surgery.
- Ensure to follow any specific pre-op instructions provided by your clinic or medical coordinator.
- Stay well-hydrated and inform the clinic of any medications you are taking.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you if possible for additional support.
