# Your Guide to Prepare for Gamma Knife Trip to

# **Spain**



#### **Documents and Visa Requirements**

- Valid passport or travel document with at least three months beyond your planned date of departure from Spain.
- Check visa requirements and apply if needed via the official Spanish visa portal: http://www.exteriores.gob.es/.
- · Medical documents: referral from your doctor, medical history, and records related to your condition.
- Some clinics may provide additional diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are lacking, but it is essential to bring as much information as possible regarding your condition.



## **Accommodation Options**

Patients can expect hospital stays, partner hotels with discounts, or self-booking options. While some clinics might offer free accommodation, it is not guaranteed. A hotel stay per night can average approximately 100-150 euros, depending on the location and rating of the hotel.



#### **Transfer Services**

- Clinics may offer paid airport transfer services; inquire with your medical coordinator.
- Popular taxi services include Radio Taxi and Fono Taxi, with prices ranging based on distance; approximately 30-40 euros from the airport to the city center.



#### **Interpreter Services**

Interpreter services are often available and can be arranged through the clinic, sometimes for a fee. Ensure to communicate your needs to your personal medical coordinator for assistance.



### **Payment Methods**

- Payments can be made in cash or by card.
- The local currency is the Euro (EUR), and while some places may accept dollars or euros, it is recommended to have local currency for small expenses and convenience.



# **Pre-Op Gamma Knife Tips**

- Follow any fasting instructions provided by the clinic for the day of the procedure.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you if possible, as you may need assistance post-procedure.
- Discuss any medications you are taking with your doctor, as some may need to be stopped before the surgery.
- Wear comfortable clothing and avoid bringing valuables to the hospital.
- Prepare a list of questions or concerns to discuss with your doctor before the procedure.
- Ensure you understand the postoperative care instructions that will be provided by your Gamma Knife doctor.
