# Prepare for Your Gynecomastia Surgery Trip to Turkey



#### **Documents and Visa Requirements**

- International travelers should have a valid passport for entry into Turkey.
- Visa requirements vary by country; visit the Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System at evisa.gov.tr to check if you need a visa based on your nationality.
- · Carry medical documents such as referral notes from your local doctor and any recent medical test results relevant to your surgery.
- · Most Turkish clinics provide necessary diagnostics and tests if you lack certain medical documentation.



### **Accommodation Options**

Most clinics have partnerships with local hotels to provide patients with comfortable accommodation. Some may offer free or discounted stays. Hospital stays are typically included in the package. For self-booking, average hotel rates range from \$50 to \$150 per night, depending on the hotel's class.



#### **Transfer Services**

- Clinics often provide free airport transfers to and from the hotel and clinic.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available, with the average fare being around 3 TRY per km (approximately \$0.16 USD).



#### **Interpreter Services**

Interpreter services are typically available, either for free or at an additional cost, depending on the clinic. It is advisable to confirm this service with your chosen clinic beforehand.



#### **Payment Methods**

- Cash and credit/debit card payments are widely accepted.
- · Local currency (Turkish Lira, TRY) is essential for smaller purchases and taxi rides, though many places accept USD or EUR.



# **Pre-Op Gynecomastia Surgery Tips**

- Discuss any medications you're taking with your surgeon, as some may need to be stopped before surgery.
- Avoid smoking and alcohol at least two weeks before the procedure to promote better healing.
- Stay hydrated and maintain a healthy diet to prepare your body for surgery and recovery.
- Plan for sufficient rest and recovery time post-surgery, following your surgeon's guidelines closely.
- Bring comfortable, loose-fitting clothing for post-surgery comfort.
- Ensure you understand the post-operative care instructions before the surgery.
