Your Guide to Prepare for Hemorrhoids Treatment in Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Valid passport and, if required, a visa or an e-visa for entry into Turkey.
- Patients can check visa requirements and apply for an e-visa at the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System at www.evisa.gov.tr.
- Medical records related to Hemorrhoids, including any previous treatment history.
- Clinics in Turkey may provide diagnostic tests if the patient lacks certain medical documents.



Accommodation Options

Accommodation is not included in the treatment package. Patients have options such as hospital stays, partner hotels with discounts, or self-booking. Average hotel stay per night is approximately \$50-\$100. Accompanying person's stay conditions will vary based on the accommodation chosen.



Transfer Services

- · Some clinics offer free airport transfers, while others may charge a fee.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available in major cities, with prices starting from around 3 TRY per km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are available and may be free of charge or incur a fee depending on the clinic. It is advisable to confirm this with the medical provider beforehand.



Payment Methods

- Payment options include cash and card transactions.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY), and it is recommended to have some local cash for small expenses.
- While some establishments may accept dollars or euros, it is generally advisable to use the local currency for transactions.



Before Your Hemorrhoids Treatment

- Consult with your doctor for any pre-treatment dietary restrictions or medication adjustments.
- Plan for at least 1 day of hospital stay post-treatment; pack accordingly.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you if possible, for support during your stay.
- It's essential to stay hydrated and maintain a fiber-rich diet leading up to the treatment.
- Avoid any strenuous activities a few days before the procedure.
- Inform your medical coordinator of any allergies or special medical conditions.
- Ensure you have travel insurance that covers medical treatments abroad.
- Follow any additional preoperative instructions provided by your treatment doctor.
