

Your Guide to Prepare for Immunotherapy Trip to Germany



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Ensure you have a valid passport with at least six months remaining before expiration.
- Visit the German Federal Foreign Office website or consult the German embassy in your country to check visa requirements: [auswaertiges-amt.de](https://www.auswaertiges-amt.de).
- Prepare a detailed medical history, recent test results, and any previous treatment records related to your cancer.
- German clinics may provide additional diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are missing. Contact the clinic beforehand to confirm what is needed.



Accommodation Options

Accommodation is not included in the medical procedure package. You can book a hotel room independently or take advantage of special partner prices arranged by medical travel companies. Hospital stays will be arranged as per medical necessity. Average hotel stay per night in Germany ranges from 70 to 150 euros.



Transfer Services

- Clinics offer regular transfer services; inquire whether these are complimentary or require an additional fee.
- Taxis are readily available in major German cities. Average fares start from 3 euros per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are available for non-German speakers. While some clinics offer this service for free, others may charge a fee. Confirm with your clinic in advance.



Payment Methods

- Payments can usually be made using cash or credit/debit cards.
- The local currency is the Euro (EUR), and it is advisable to have some on hand for small expenses.
- Some places may accept payment in dollars or euros, but it's best to have local currency for convenience.



Pre-Op Immunotherapy Tips

- Follow any fasting instructions provided by your doctor before the procedure.
- Discuss any medications you are taking with your doctor, as some may need to be paused.
- Plan for adequate rest and recovery time following your immunotherapy.
- Maintain a healthy diet and stay hydrated in the days leading up to your treatment.
- Prepare a list of questions or concerns to discuss with your immunotherapy doctor.
- Inform the clinic of any allergies or sensitivities to medications or materials.
- Consider the season and pack appropriate clothing for your stay in Germany.
- Ensure you have travel insurance that covers medical procedures abroad.
