

Prepare for Your Immunotherapy Trip to Spain



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Valid passport or travel document, with at least three months validity beyond your planned date of departure from the Schengen area.
- Check visa requirements based on your country of origin at the official Spanish visa portal: [Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Spain](#).
- Medical documents: referral from your doctor, medical history, details of previous treatments, and any relevant scans or test results.
- Clinics in Spain, such as the Teknon Medical Centre, may provide diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are lacking.



Accommodation Options

Patients undergoing treatment at Teknon Medical Centre in Barcelona have various accommodation options. The clinic may offer partnerships with nearby hotels at special rates. It is advisable to check whether the clinic provides free accommodation or if there will be additional costs. The average hotel stay per night in Barcelona ranges from 100 to 250 euros, depending on the hotel's category and location.



Transfer Services

- Clinics may offer free or paid airport transfer services. It's essential to confirm this with the clinic beforehand.
- Popular taxi services in Barcelona include Taxi Barcelona and Barcelona Airport Taxis, with approximate prices starting from 30 euros for a city transfer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are typically available upon request. Some clinics may provide this service for free, while others may charge an additional fee. It is recommended to clarify this with the clinic prior to your visit.



Payment Methods

- Payment options include cash and card transactions.
- The local currency is the Euro (EUR), and having local cash is recommended for smaller expenses.
- While some establishments may accept dollars or euros, it is generally advisable to carry local currency for convenience.



Pre-Op Immunotherapy Tips

- Consult with your local doctor about immunotherapy and any potential interactions with current medications.
- Ensure all vaccinations are up-to-date before traveling to Spain.
- Maintain a balanced diet and stay hydrated in the days leading up to your trip.
- Bring a list of questions and concerns to discuss with Dr. Capdevila during your consultation.
- Arrange for travel insurance that covers medical treatment abroad.
- Keep a digital and physical copy of all your medical records and prescriptions.
- Follow all pre-operative instructions provided by your medical coordinator or the clinic.
- Plan for adequate rest and recovery time post-treatment as advised by your doctor.
