Prepare for Your Veneers Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Turkey.
- e-Visa application through www.evisa.gov.tr for eligible countries or pre-arrival visa procedures for others.
- · Medical records, dental history, and any dental x-rays if available.
- Clinics in Turkey provide diagnostics like panoramic X-rays, intraoral imaging, and 3D CT scans if you lack certain documents.



Accommodation Options

Clinics offer packages including 4* or 5* hotel stays, typically for 3 to 5 days. For full-mouth treatments, an all-inclusive 5-Star Hotel & VIP Transfer is included. If self-booking, the average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150.



Transfer Services

- Free transfer airport-hotel-clinic-airport is included in veneer packages.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi offer rides with fares starting around \$0.40 per km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided for free by the clinic. If not, there are paid services available which can be arranged through the clinic or independently.



Payment Methods

- Payment options include cash and card transactions.
- The local currency is Turkish Lira (TRY), and it's advisable to have some for small expenses.
- Many places accept payments in dollars or euros, but exchange rates may vary.



Pre-Op Veneers Tips

- Consult with your dentist regarding any medications or supplements you're taking.
- Avoid smoking and alcohol at least a week before the procedure as they can affect healing.
- Discuss any concerns or allergies with your dentist beforehand.
- Maintain good oral hygiene but avoid over-brushing or using harsh dental products leading up to the procedure.
- Plan for adequate recovery time and follow a soft food diet post-procedure as advised by your dentist.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you on the day of the procedure if possible.
- Have a communication method set up with your personal medical coordinator provided by Bookimed for any on-trip assistance.
- Ensure you have access to ice packs or cold compresses to manage any potential swelling.
