

# Your Guide to Prepare for Immunotherapy with Keytruda (Pembolizumab) Trip in Spain



## Documents and Visa Requirements

- Valid passport with at least 6 months remaining before expiration.
- Check visa requirements based on your country of origin at the official Spanish consulate or embassy website, or through online portals like SchengenVisaInfo (<https://www.schengenvisainfo.com/spain-visa/>).
- Medical referral letter for Immunotherapy with Keytruda (Pembolizumab).
- Recent medical reports and any relevant medical history documentation.
- Spanish clinics may provide additional diagnostics and tests if you lack certain medical documents, such as complete blood count with cancer markers and a proteinogram.



## Accommodation Options

Accommodation is not provided for free by the clinics. Patients can choose from partner hotels with special rates or book accommodations independently. Hospital stays are typically not required for this procedure. The average hotel stay per night is approximately 100-150 Euros.



## Transfer Services

- Clinics in Spain may offer paid airport transfers; inquire in advance for arrangements and costs.
- Popular taxi services like Taxi Madrid or Barcelona Taxi operate in major cities, with approximate prices ranging from 30 to 50 Euros for airport-city transfers.



## Interpreter Services

Interpreter services may be available through the clinic, sometimes for an additional fee. Ensure to request these services in advance if needed.



## Payment Methods

- Clinics in Spain accept payments via cash or credit/debit cards.
- The local currency is the Euro (EUR), and having local cash is beneficial for smaller purchases or where cards are not accepted.
- While some places may accept dollars or euros, it's advisable to exchange currency for a comfortable travel experience.



## Pre-Op Immunotherapy with Keytruda (Pembolizumab) Tips

- Discuss all medications and supplements you are taking with your doctor, as some may need to be adjusted or stopped before treatment.
- Maintain a healthy diet and stay hydrated in the days leading up to your treatment.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you or be available for support during your stay in Spain.
- Follow any fasting instructions provided by your clinic prior to the treatment.
- Prepare a list of questions or concerns you may have regarding your treatment to discuss with your doctor.
- Ensure you have comprehensive travel insurance that covers medical treatments abroad.
- Take all prescribed pre-treatment medications as directed by your healthcare provider.
- All postoperative instructions will be given by your Immunotherapy with Keytruda (Pembolizumab) doctor.
