Your Guide to Prepare for

Leukemia Treatment in

Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Valid passport and possibly a visa depending on your country of origin.
- · Check visa requirements on the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System or at Turkish consulates.
- · Medical reports, history, and recent test results relevant to your Leukemia condition.
- Diagnostic tests available at Turkish clinics if additional documents are needed.



Accommodation Options

Accommodation is not typically included in medical packages, but clinics often help with booking hotels. Average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$200. Accompanying person's stay conditions are usually aligned with patient accommodations, often with the option to stay in the same room or hotel.



Transfer Services

- Clinics may offer free or paid airport transfers.
- Popular taxi services include BiTaksi and iTaksi, with approximate prices starting from 0.5 USD per km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided, sometimes for a fee, to assist with language barriers during medical consultations and hospital stays.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made in cash or by card.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira, but many places also accept dollars or euros.
- · Having some local currency is advisable for smaller expenses and where card payments are not accepted.



Before Your Leukemia Treatment

- Understand the details of your treatment plan and any preparatory steps you need to take.
- Discuss with your doctor any medications you are currently taking that may need to be paused.
- Plan for recovery time and any necessary support you'll need at home post-treatment.
- Pack appropriately for your stay, including any medical records and personal items that will make your stay more comfortable.
- Ensure you have travel insurance that covers medical treatment abroad.
- Stay hydrated and follow any dietary guidelines provided by your medical team.
- Prepare a list of questions or concerns to discuss with your healthcare provider in Turkey.
- Keep emergency contact information on hand, including your medical coordinator's details.
