Prepare for Your Liver cancer Treatment in Germany



Documents and Visa Requirements

- · Valid passport or travel document.
- Visa, if required check Germany's Federal Foreign Office website for visa requirements based on your country.
- · Medical documents: referral from your doctor, medical history, imaging results, pathology reports.
- · German clinics can provide additional diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are unavailable.



Accommodation Options

Many German clinics offer partnerships with local hotels for discounted rates. While hospital stays for the treatment are typically included, the cost of extra nights in a hotel will vary, averaging around €100 per night. Accommodation for an accompanying person is often available, though conditions and costs can vary, so it's best to check with the clinic beforehand.



Transfer Services

- Clinics may offer free or paid airport transfers inquire directly with the clinic for their services.
- Common taxi services, such as Taxi Deutschland, operate in major cities with fares starting around €3 base plus €2 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are typically available, often for a fee. Some clinics may include this service for free with certain treatment packages. It's advisable to confirm with your clinic ahead of your visit.



Payment Methods

- · Most clinics accept cash and credit/debit cards.
- Local currency is the Euro (€), and it is recommended to have some on hand for small expenses. Many places also accept payment in
 dollars or euros.



Before Your Liver cancer Treatment

- Consult with your local doctor about the specifics of your condition and treatment plan.
- Ensure you have a list of all medications and dosages you are currently taking.
- Prepare your body for treatment by maintaining a healthy diet and avoiding alcohol.
- Organize your travel insurance and any necessary health insurance coverage.
- Arrange for someone to assist you during your recovery period.
- Follow any pre-treatment instructions given by your clinic, such as fasting before surgery.
- Keep all your medical records and personal identification documents in a safe and easily accessible place during travel.
