Prepare for Your Liver cancer Treatment in Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport valid for at least six months beyond your stay.
- Visa, if required for your nationality. Verify at Turkey's e-Visa website.
- Medical reports, imaging (like CT scans/MRIs), and biopsy results.
- · Local clinics may provide diagnostics and tests if previous medical documents are incomplete.



Accommodation Options

Hospital stays are included in treatment packages. Partner hotels offer discounts, but self-booking is an option. Average hotel cost is about \$50-\$100 per night. Accompanying person's stay conditions vary by clinic.



Transfer Services

- · Clinics often provide free airport transfers.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi offer rides; costs vary with distance and city, approximately \$0.50-\$1.00 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are generally available, sometimes free of charge but could incur costs depending on the clinic's policies.



Payment Methods

- Both cash and card payments are accepted.
- · Local currency (Turkish Lira) is recommended for smaller expenses, but dollars or euros are widely accepted.



Before Your Liver cancer Treatment

- Discuss all medications and supplements with your doctor; some may need to be paused.
- Follow any fasting instructions before procedures.
- Plan for recovery time and post-treatment care.
- Bring comfortable clothing for your hospital stay and post-treatment recovery.
- Ensure you have adequate travel insurance covering medical treatment abroad.
- Stay hydrated and maintain a healthy diet as advised by your doctor.
- Prepare a list of questions or concerns to discuss with your medical team.
