

Prepare for Your Lung Cancer Treatment in Spain



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Valid passport or travel document with at least six months before expiration.
- Visa may be required depending on your country of origin. Check the Spanish consulate or embassy website for specifics.
- Medical documents such as your diagnosis, medical history, and any previous treatment records.
- Clinics in Spain can provide diagnostic tests like electrocardiogram and blood tests if you lack certain medical documents.



Accommodation Options

Accommodation is not included in the treatment package. Patients can book hotels or apartments themselves. The average price for a hotel stay per night is approximately €50-€150. Conditions for accompanying persons will depend on the hotel's policy – some may offer discounts or complimentary stays for caregivers.



Transfer Services

- Transfer services are not included in the treatment package.
- Popular taxi services like Taxi Madrid or Radio Taxi Barcelona can be used, with prices starting from around €20-€30 for a trip within the city.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are not typically included in the treatment package. They may be available at an additional cost, which will vary depending on the service provider.



Payment Methods

- Payment options include cash and credit/debit cards.
- The local currency is the Euro (€). It is recommended to have local currency for small expenses.
- Some places may accept payment in dollars or euros, but it is not guaranteed.



Before Your Lung Cancer Treatment

- Ensure all your medical records are up to date and bring copies with you.
- Discuss with your doctor any medications you are taking and how they might impact your treatment.
- Consider learning a few phrases in Spanish or have a translation app handy for basic communication.
- Prepare a list of emergency contacts, including your medical coordinator's information.
- Make arrangements for your home and work responsibilities during your treatment and recovery period.
- Pack comfortable clothing and any personal items you may need during your stay.
- Check with your insurance provider about coverage for overseas medical treatment and travel insurance.
- Follow any pre-treatment instructions given by your lung cancer treatment doctor.
