Documents and Visa Requirements

- Valid passport and, if required, a visa. Check visa requirements on the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System based on your nationality.
- · Medical documents like health records, diagnostic images, and pathology reports.
- · Clinics in Turkey may provide additional diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are missing.



Accommodation Options

Most clinics offer hospital stays for the duration of the treatment. Partner hotels may provide discounts, and assistance with booking is available. Average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150. Accommodation for an accompanying person is available, conditions vary by clinic.



Transfer Services

- · Clinics often provide free airport transfers.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi offer rides at varying rates, usually starting from around 4 TL (\$0.22) per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are available, sometimes at no additional cost. Costs may vary depending on the clinic and language required.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made in cash or by card.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TL), and having local cash is recommended for smaller expenses.
- Payments in USD or EUR are possible in some clinics and tourist areas.



Before Your Lung Cancer Treatment

- Consult with your local doctor about the planned treatment and any necessary preparations.
- Ensure you have an adequate supply of any current medications to last through your trip.
- Discuss dietary restrictions or recommendations with your medical team in Turkey prior to arrival.
- Prepare a list of questions and concerns to discuss with your Turkish medical team.
- Consider packing items for comfort during hospital stays, such as a robe or slippers.
- Bring copies of all medical reports and imaging that are relevant to your treatment.
- Inform your credit card company of your travel plans to avoid any issues with payments abroad.
- All postoperative care instructions will be provided by your lung cancer treatment doctor in Turkey.
