Your Guide to Prepare for Neuritis of the Facial Nerve Treatment Trip in Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of entry into Turkey.
- Visa, if required for your nationality. Visit e-Visa Turkey or the Turkish consulate website for details.
- · Medical reports detailing Neuritis of the facial nerve condition and any previous treatments.
- Proof of medical insurance or finances to cover the treatment.
- Clinics in Turkey may offer diagnostic services like EEG, Head MRI, and blood tests if you lack certain medical documents.



Accommodation Options

Clinics may provide hospitalization during the treatment, followed by a hotel stay for recovery. Partner hotels often offer discounted rates. For self-booking, expect an average hotel stay per night to range between \$50-\$150. Accompanying person's stay conditions may vary and should be confirmed with the clinic or hotel.



Transfer Services

- Clinics often provide free airport-hotel-clinic-airport transfers.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available, with rates starting from around 1.5 TRY/km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are commonly available, sometimes free of charge or for a fee depending on the clinic's policy. Confirm availability and cost beforehand.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made with cash or card.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY), and having local cash is recommended for smaller expenses.
- Many places accept payments in dollars or euros, but it's advantageous to have local currency for ease of transactions.



Before Your Neuritis of the facial nerve Treatment

- · Consult with your local doctor about the planned treatment and any necessary pre-treatment care.
- Ensure you have a list of all medications you are currently taking to provide to your doctor in Turkey.
- Plan for a companion if needed, as having support during recovery can be very helpful.
- Follow any preoperative instructions given by your clinic, which might include fasting or medication adjustments.
- Prepare a recovery kit with items you may need post-treatment, such as comfortable clothing and personal care items.
- Arrange for any necessary post-treatment care or accommodations in your home country prior to your departure.
- Learn a few phrases in Turkish or download a translation app to ease communication during your stay.
- Keep the contact details of your medical coordinator and the clinic handy for any questions or concerns.
