Prepare for Your Penis Enlargement Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- · Valid passport or travel document with an expiration date at least 60 days beyond the duration of stay.
- Visa requirements vary based on country; visit the official Republic of Turkey electronic visa application system at evisa.gov.tr or check with the Turkish consulate.
- · Medical documents such as health history, any previous surgical records, and a list of medications currently taken.
- Clinics in Turkey may provide diagnostic tests if required medical documents are not available.



Accommodation Options

Many clinics offer hospital stays during the procedure, followed by accommodation at partner 4* hotels. While some may offer these amenities for free, others may charge additional costs. On average, a hotel stay per night may range from \$50 to \$150.



Transfer Services

- Clinics often offer free airport transfers; confirm with your clinic if this applies to your package.
- Popular taxi services include BiTaksi and iTaksi with fares starting around 3 TRY (\$0.16) per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often provided by the clinics, sometimes at no additional cost. It's important to confirm this with your clinic ahead of your trip.



Payment Methods

- · Clinics usually accept cash and credit/debit card payments.
- Local currency (Turkish Lira TRY) is preferred for smaller expenses; ATMs are widely available.
- Payments in USD or EUR are accepted at some places, but it's advisable to carry local currency.



Pre-Op Penis Enlargement Tips

- Consult with your primary care physician before traveling for surgery.
- Ensure you have all necessary vaccinations as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- Avoid taking aspirin or anti-inflammatory drugs which can increase bleeding.
- Maintain a healthy diet and stay hydrated leading up to the surgery.
- Refrain from smoking at least two weeks before the procedure to promote better healing.
- Arrange for someone to assist you post-surgery if needed.
- Discuss your current medications with your surgeon to avoid any potential interactions.
- Be aware of all postoperative instructions provided by your penis enlargement doctor.
