Documents and Visa Requirements

- · Passport valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Turkey.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the official Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System at www.evisa.gov.tr or contact the Turkish consulate.
- Medical and dental records related to your dental health.
- Clinics in Turkey often provide diagnostics like panoramic X-rays if needed.



Accommodation Options

Many clinics offer package deals that include accommodation in partner hotels. For full-mouth treatments, an all-inclusive 5-Star Hotel & VIP Transfer are often included. Otherwise, you may need to self-book. Hospital stays are typically not required. Average hotel price per night is around \$50-\$150, depending on the hotel's class and location.



Transfer Services

- Clinics usually offer free airport transfers for patients; confirm with your clinic.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available in major cities, with an average fare of \$0.5-\$1 per km.



Interpreter Services

Language assistance is often provided by clinics, either complimentary or for an additional fee. Be sure to inquire about this service beforehand.



Payment Methods

- Payment can be made in cash or via card.
- Local currency (Turkish Lira) is needed, but some clinics may accept Dollars or Euros.
- · Having local cash is recommended for smaller expenses.



Pre-Op Porcelain Veneer Tips

- Maintain good oral hygiene before the procedure to ensure the best outcome.
- Discuss any medications you're taking with your dentist, as they may affect treatment.
- Avoid smoking and alcohol before the procedure, as they can impede healing.
- Plan to rest after the procedure; avoid scheduling strenuous activities.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you on the day of the procedure, if possible.
- Wear comfortable clothing to the clinic on the day of your appointment.
- Bring a list of questions or concerns to discuss with your dentist during the consultation.
- · Remember that each patient's case is unique, so follow any personalized pre-op instructions given by your dentist.
