

Prepare for Your Prostatitis Treatment in Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport with at least six months of validity for international travel to Turkey.
- Visit the Republic of Turkey Electronic Visa Application System (evisa.gov.tr) or the nearest Turkish consulate to check visa requirements based on your country of origin.
- Medical reports and history detailing your Prostatitis condition.
- Diagnostic tests such as PSA levels, ultrasound reports, or any relevant imaging scans can be provided by Turkish clinics if needed.



Accommodation Options

Patients can expect comfortable accommodation options in Turkey. Clinics may offer free or discounted stays in partner 5-star hotels. Hospital stays are typically included in the treatment plan. For self-booking, the average hotel stay per night is approximately \$50 to \$150. Accompanying persons may stay with the patient, conditions may vary depending on the clinic and hotel policies.



Transfer Services

- Complimentary airport transfers to and from the hotel and clinic are often provided.
- For personal travel, popular taxi services like BiTaksi and iTaksi are available with prices starting at around 1.50 TRY/km.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are generally available, either complimentary or at an additional cost, depending on the clinic's policies. It is advisable to confirm this service before your trip.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made using cash or credit/debit cards.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY), and having local cash can be helpful for smaller expenses.
- Many places also accept payments in dollars or euros, but it is recommended to carry some local currency for convenience.



Before Your Prostatitis Treatment

- Consult with your local doctor about your travel and treatment plans.
- Ensure you have a list of all current medications and their dosages.
- Discuss any dietary restrictions or allergies with your medical coordinator beforehand.
- Plan for a recovery period; inquire about the length of stay required post-treatment.
- Stay hydrated and maintain a healthy diet leading up to the procedure.
- Organize all necessary personal documents, insurance, and emergency contacts.
- Understand the potential risks and outcomes by discussing them with your treating doctor in Turkey.
- Adhere to any preoperative instructions given by your treatment facility.
