

Your Guide to Prepare for Radiofrequency Ablation Trip to Germany



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport valid for at least 6 months after the intended date of departure from Germany.
- Schengen visa for short stays up to 90 days. Visit www.schengenvisainfo.com/germany-visa/ to check visa requirements based on your country of origin.
- Medical documents: referral from a local doctor, medical history, and any relevant previous treatment records.
- Clinics in Germany will perform diagnostic tests if necessary medical documents are insufficient.



Accommodation Options

Patients will be accommodated in a two-bed ward. Full board feeding is included. Partner hotels may offer special discounts, but booking will be self-arranged. The average hotel stay per night is approximately €80-€120. Free accommodation is not typically provided by clinics.



Transfer Services

- Clinics may offer free or paid airport transfers; inquire directly with the clinic for details.
- Popular taxi services like MyTaxi or Free Now are available, with prices starting at around €3 base fare plus €1-€2 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services may be available upon request. Typically, these services are not free and costs vary depending on the language and duration of services required.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made using cash or card.
- The local currency is the Euro (€), and it is advisable to have local cash for small expenses.
- Some establishments may accept dollars or euros, but it is not guaranteed.



Pre-Op Radiofrequency ablation Tips

- Discuss any medications you are taking with your doctor, as some may need to be stopped before the procedure.
- Follow any fasting instructions given by your doctor before the ablation.
- Plan for a recovery period; avoid strenuous activities as advised by your doctor.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you during your stay, if possible.
- Bring comfortable clothing and necessary personal items for your hospital stay.
- Stay hydrated and follow a healthy diet as part of your preparation for the procedure.
- Inquire about the risk deposit and understand the terms for its return post-procedure.
- All postoperative instructions will be provided by your Radiofrequency ablation doctor.
