

Prepare for Your Rehabilitation for Children with Cerebral Palsy Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport valid for at least six months beyond your stay.
- Visa, if required (check [e-Visa](#) for Turkey based on your nationality).
- Medical records detailing cerebral palsy condition and any previous treatments.
- Clinics in Turkey often provide diagnostic tests if certain medical documents are missing.



Accommodation Options

4* or 5* hotel accommodations are provided, with some clinics including the cost in the package price. Hospital stays are typically part of the treatment plan. Partner hotels may offer discounted rates. Average hotel stay per night ranges from \$50 to \$150.



Transfer Services

- VIP airport transfers are often included in the medical package.
- Popular taxi services like BiTaksi or iTaksi are available, with an average fare of \$0.50 to \$0.70 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are available, sometimes included in the medical package or may incur additional costs depending on the clinic's policies.



Payment Methods

- Payments can be made using cash or credit card.
- Local currency (Turkish Lira) is needed for smaller expenses; ATMs are widely available.
- Many places also accept dollars or euros, but local currency is recommended for convenience.



Pre-Op Rehabilitation for children with cerebral palsy Tips

- Consult with your healthcare provider to discuss your child's specific needs before traveling.
- Prepare a list of medications and a medical summary to share with your medical team in Turkey.
- Plan for potential communication needs by learning key phrases in Turkish or arranging for an interpreter.
- Ensure your child is up-to-date with immunizations recommended for international travel.
- Pack any specialty items or comfort items your child may need during the trip and stay.
- Establish a point of contact at the treatment facility to assist with any pre-arrival questions.
- Consider travel insurance that covers medical treatments abroad and unexpected travel changes.
- Rest assured that postoperative instructions will be provided by your child's rehabilitation doctor.
