Your Guide to Prepare for Rhinoplasty (nose job) Trip to Germany



Documents and Visa Requirements

- · Passport with at least six months of validity beyond your planned departure date from Germany.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the German Federal Foreign Office website or contact your local German consulate.
- · Medical documents: medical history, any previous rhinoplasty operations, and a letter from your local doctor.
- Clinics in Germany can provide diagnostics and tests, such as blood work and imaging, if necessary.



Accommodation Options

Clinics typically offer a two-bed ward for patients; however, this is not free of charge. Partner hotels may offer discounts, but self-booking is also an option. The average hotel stay per night in Germany is about $\ensuremath{\in} 90-\ensuremath{\in} 150$.



Transfer Services

- Some clinics offer free airport transfers, otherwise, the service is paid.
- Popular taxi services like Free Now or local services; prices start from around €3 base fare plus €2 per kilometer.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services can be arranged by clinics or through independent providers. Costs vary, and while some clinics might include this service for free, others might charge additional fees.



Payment Methods

- · Payment options include cash and credit/debit cards.
- · Germany's local currency is the Euro (EUR), and having local cash is recommended for small expenses.
- · While some places accept dollars or euros, it's generally advisable to pay with the local currency for the best exchange rates.



Pre-Op Rhinoplasty (nose job) Tips

- Consult with your surgeon about medications to avoid before surgery, such as blood thinners or NSAIDs.
- Stop smoking at least two weeks before the procedure to promote better healing.
- Avoid alcohol for at least one week prior to surgery.
- Maintain a healthy diet and stay hydrated to support your recovery process.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you on the day of surgery.
- Prepare a comfortable recovery area at home with necessary supplies within easy reach.
- Follow any specific pre-operative instructions given by your rhinoplasty surgeon or clinic.
