# Your Guide to Prepare for Stem cell therapy Trip to Spain



#### **Documents and Visa Requirements**

- · Valid passport or travel document that remains valid for at least three months beyond your intended date of departure from Spain.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the official Spanish consulate or embassy website in your country or visit <a href="www.exteriores.gob.es">www.exteriores.gob.es</a> for more information.
- · Medical documents such as referral from your local doctor, medical history records, and any previous treatment reports.
- Clinics in Spain may provide diagnostics and tests if you do not have certain medical documents, but confirm this with your chosen clinic beforehand



#### **Accommodation Options**

Accommodation is not included in the treatment package. Clinics in Spain may have partner hotels offering discounts. It is advisable to self-book accommodation in advance, considering proximity to the clinic. Average hotel stay per night ranges from €50 to €150, depending on the location and hotel category.



## **Transfer Services**

- · Clinics may offer free or paid airport transfer services; check with your clinic for specific arrangements.
- Popular taxi services such as Taxi Barcelona and MyTaxi operate in major cities with approximate prices starting at €20 for short trips.



# **Interpreter Services**

Interpreter services might be available for a fee. Confirm with your clinic if they offer this service for free or what the costs might be.



### **Payment Methods**

- Payment options typically include cash and credit/debit cards.
- The local currency is the Euro (€), and it is recommended to have local currency for small expenses, although many places accept major foreign currencies like US dollars or euros.



## Pre-Op Stem cell therapy Tips

- Discuss with your doctor any medications you are taking and their compatibility with the therapy.
- · Avoid smoking and alcohol consumption before the treatment as they can affect the success of the therapy.
- Maintain a healthy diet and stay hydrated to prepare your body for recovery.
- Arrange for someone to accompany you if possible, for support during your medical journey.
- Follow any pre-operative instructions provided by your clinic, including fasting guidelines.
- Ensure you have a clear understanding of the post-treatment care and any potential signs of complications.
- Keep a list of emergency contacts and the clinic's information readily accessible.
- Plan for adequate rest and recovery time post-therapy in your travel itinerary.
