

Prepare for Your Vaccination Trip to Turkey



Documents and Visa Requirements

- Passport valid for at least six months from the date of entry into Turkey.
- Visa requirements vary by country; check the current requirements for your country of origin at the official Republic of Turkey e-Visa website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>).
- Necessary medical documents include medical history records and any previous vaccination certificates if applicable.
- Clinics may provide diagnostics and tests if certain medical documents are lacking, at the cost of around 400 Turkish Lira per dose of vaccine (approximately 30 USD*).



Accommodation Options

Patients can choose from a variety of accommodation options, including hospital stays, partner hotels at discounted rates, or self-booking. Clinics in Turkey may or may not provide free accommodation. The average hotel stay per night can range from 50 to 150 USD, depending on the hotel's rating and location.



Transfer Services

- Many clinics offer free airport transfers; otherwise, patients can avail of airport-hotel-clinic-airport transfers as part of their medical travel package.
- Popular taxi services in Turkey include BiTaksi and iTaksi, with average prices ranging from 20 to 40 TL (approximately 1.5 to 3 USD) for short distances.



Interpreter Services

Interpreter services are often available through the clinic, either free of charge or for an additional fee. It is advisable to confirm the availability and cost of these services in advance.



Payment Methods

- Payment options include cash and credit/debit card.
- The local currency is the Turkish Lira (TL), and it is recommended to have local cash for minor expenses.
- Many places also accept payments in dollars or euros, but it's always best to have local currency for convenience.



Pre-Op Vaccination Tips

- Ensure all routine vaccinations are up to date before traveling.
- Consult with your healthcare provider regarding any specific vaccines recommended for Turkey.
- Stay hydrated and well-rested before the vaccination.
- Bring a copy of your medical records and any previous vaccination documents.
- Inform the vaccination clinic of any allergies or medical conditions.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing for easy access to the vaccination site.
- Plan for a day of rest post-vaccination if possible to monitor any side effects.
- All postoperative instructions will be given by your Vaccination doctor.
